Four arrested at problem house in Beverly Hills

During the morning of Thursday, February 23, the Citrus County Sheriff's Office conducted a search warrant at 34 South Jeffery Street in Beverly Hills after detectives received multiple complaints of drug activity at the house. The residence has been a problem in the neighborhood for some time and has become a constant thorn in the side of the community. The occupants of the home have been involved in thefts in the area, neighborhood disturbances, and drug activity for years.

Detectives with the Tactical Impact Unit's Narcotics Squad were able to establish probable cause for a search of the property. When detectives arrived, they were met with resistance from some of the occupants. Kimberly Blom refused to comply with verbal commands and was subsequently arrested for interfering with a search warrant. Once secured, the search revealed illegally possessed prescription medication and many items of drug paraphernalia. Such items were used to ingest, inhale, or inject drugs like methamphetamine, cocaine, marijuana, and illegal prescription medication. The following arrests were a result of this investigation:
